Some information and reminders follow:

Team Payments: Thank you to those States which have already paid in full. ***Just a reminder that final payment is due Thursday 31 July.***

Team Lists are required by 24 July. Please ensure that the Name & Contact Number of each State Team Manager is forwarded with your Team Lists.

Championship Handbook: Teams will each receive two copies of the Handbook. A printable copy will be available online to all States and NZ by mid-August.

Team Managers/ Team Captains must ensure the team list is entered daily on Play HQ. Some matches are being live scored, and a Division 1 match will be live streamed from Maroochydore CC daily.

Match Starting Times: Players are advised that all matches commence at 10.00 am on the first three playing days. On day 4 all finals will be played at Maroochydore CC commencing at 10.00 am. All playoff matches at other centres will start at 9.30 am to allow teams to make their way back to Maroochydore CC in time for Presentations and BBQ. Former test Player and Chairman of Selectors, Trevor Hohns, will present the Trophies.

Player Health & Safety is a priority for the Organising Committee. A Medical Form has been attached and must be completed and held by each Team Captain or Manager.
